### Welcome and Introductions

Ms. Baird welcomed those present and roundtable introductions ensued.

### Review of work completed since last meeting

**Additional Information/Data Collected:** Ms. Baird provided an update of the staff work completed since the last meeting including an updated list of interviews and additional data collected.

**Logic Models:** Ms. Baird provided a review of two draft logic models created based on group input during the previous 2 meetings and the data that was collected and analyzed. The group agreed to adopt the logic models as working-versions that can be changed as the process continues.

### Best Practices Overview

Senta Goudy provided an overview of the Department of Children and Families' Evidence Based Strategies guidelines and the national perspective on evidence based strategies and environmental strategies.

**Group Discussion:** Ms. Goudy led a discussion of potential evidence based strategies that would fit the current draft logic models. The group discussed a variety of potential strategies including:

**Adult Logic Model:**

- Enhancing Sheriff's drug take back effort
- Providing training and materials to physicians (targeted physicians—those most likely to prescribe the commonly abused prescription drugs) Explore training partnership with hospitals.
- Local marketing of PDMP, if/when implemented
- Community Education regarding the addictive nature of commonly abuse prescription drugs
- Continued work on legislation that the Substance Abuse Taskforce proposed

**Youth Logic Model:**

- Assess parental attitudes about marijuana use and launch education campaign to address norms or misconceptions
- Identify local availability (ask LEO-locally grown?)
- Provide drug testing kits (or information about them) to parents as deterrent for youth use
- Explore opportunity to implement a prevention strategy with youth through civil citation program

**Next Steps and Next Meeting:**

The group agreed to review and provide feedback on the logic model as further information is collected via email. One Voice staff will work to collect additional information, including an inventory of best practices that currently exist that address the draft logic models. Unless it is determined that another meeting to work on the logic models is needed, the planning (final) meeting will be: May 25, 2011, 9:30 to 11:00 a.m. at the Volusia County Health Department.
